Dear Mr. Hayden:

Energen Resources recently finished a pay add and down hole commingling operations on the subject well. In accordance with the approved Administrative Order, the supervisor of the Aztec District Office of the NMOCD shall determine the proper production allocation.

Prior to commingling operations, the Pictured Cliffs produced at a stabilized rate of 35 MCFD & 0 BOPD. Production in the Mesa Verde was re-established and the well was returned to production in June 2001. The well has stabilized at a rate of 50 MCFD & 0.5 BOPD. The following allocation is recommended:
