ConocoPhillips is requesting Onsite remediation utilizing a Landfarm as part of our corrective action plan in compliance with 19.15.29.11. The Land farm will be used to remediate the contaminated soil from the release that occurred on September 11, 2009. The land farm will be adequately bermed to contain any runoff fluids. The contaminated soil will be turned at a minimum once a month. Any standing fluids will be removed within 72 hours. The landfarm will be tested quarterly until closure status can be reached. The soil will not be transferred off site without the OCD's approval. No additional soils will be added to the land farm other than what was excavated due to the above mentioned release without the OCD's approval. We have acquired the Landowners approval for the onsite remediation. Once the soil has reached closure status we will remove berms, spread remediated soil, re-contour and seed.

Another C-103 for closure will be filed with the sample results attached once the soil has been remediated.
