Reference is made to your well No. 10 San Isidro 16 located 1980' FSL & 1980' FEL sec. 16, T. 20 N., R. 3 W., Sandoval County, New Mexico, Lease NMNM-105185. Also referenced is High Plains' Sundry Notice dated July 26, 2008, which stated the well would be logged, frac and place the well on production. According to our records this well has been inactive for over fifteen years, you are required to either complete the work approved, placing the well on production or plug the well following approval from this office. You have until April 30, 2010 to complete the above.

No additional extensions will be granted.

Failure to comply within the time above may result in an assessment in accordance with 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management (NM-93000), P. O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115. Such requests shall not result in a suspension of the order(s) unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et seq.
