

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Water line from separator to water tank froze and broke causing the pump to discharge produced water into lined, earthen berm (secondary containment). Upon discovery, the pump was turned off and standing water was immediately recovered.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Produced water was discharged into the lined, earthen berm secondary containment. Standing fluid was recovered and hauled as produced water. The remainder of the water was frozen and is being vacuumed off as it thaws. The berm is lined, so no impacts occurred outside of secondary containment.
