

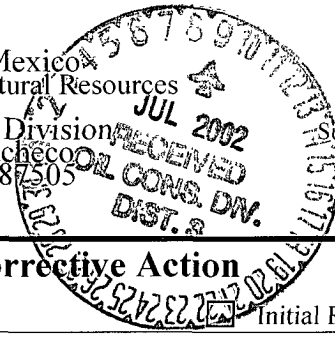

BECAUSE OF THE SPILL ESTIMATION OF 62 GALS IT IS BELIEVE THAT THEFT PLAY A.PART IN THE EVENT. THE STATE POLICE WERE NOIFIED (STATE TROOPER BRANDON HENDERSON). ALL FREE OIL WAS PICKED UP (2 GALS).

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

PREPARED SURFACE FREE OF VEGETATION. CONTAMINATED SOIL WAS REMOVED AND TAKEN TO ENVIROTECH LANDFILL.
