Operator failed to get to location due to poor road conditions and well produced abnormal amount of liquids. Tanks overfilled into bermed containment. Well was shut in to stop production of fluids and water truck and Giant were notified to remove liquids 1/28/05.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Operator last inspected the location on 1/18/05 and production and tank free board were normal and sufficient. Water truck recovered 9.5 bbls of oil and water collected around the open top water tank. Ground was frozen solid and recovery of liquids was good. Soil impacts were reported to be minor and soils will be raked and turned insitu to promote natural attenuation of impacted soils.
