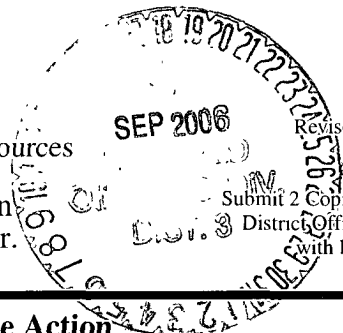

The seal on the lines between two storage tanks leaked at the connections after tanks were equalized. The connections were intact but not tight enough to hold hydrostatic pressure of water in tank after tanks were equalized. The soils will be raked to promote evaporation.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken *
Area within the containment berm.. The water was contained inside berm and was recovered to the extent possible.
