Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* ☐ NMOCD employee (Shelly Cowden) noticed a release on XTO's location, NV Navajo 36 #1. Upon investigation it was discovered that a 2" elbow on the tubing pumping flow line blew a hole in the line causing approximately 12 barrels of produced water to be released onto the ground. The well was shut in and the release was contained with approximately 2 barrels leaving location. Appropriate notifications were made and NMOCD visited the location. A vac truck was dispatched and approximately 10 barrels of produced water was recovered.

**A vac truck was used to recover water on location and repairs were made to the flow line.**
