Fruitland Coal Re-fracture and Open Additional Pay

XTO Energy proposes to re-fracture the existing Fruitland Coal perforations and open additional Fruitland Coal perforations in the Ropco 4 #1. Currently, the Fruitland Coal is open from 874' – 924', and the Pictured Cliffs is open from 930' – 940'. The two formations are down-hole commingled. A plug will be set at 926' to isolate the Pictured Cliffs perforations from the Fruitland Coal perforations during fracturing operations. A total of 28 new perforations will be added in the Fruitland Coal from 819' – 835'. The Fruitland Coal perforations from 819' – 924' will be fractured with 203,500 lbs sand. After fracturing operations are complete, the plug at 926' will be removed, and the Pictured Cliffs and Fruitland Coal will again be down-hole commingled.
