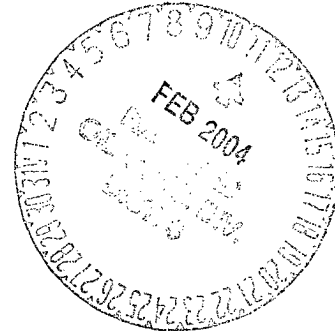

Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) the No. 1C Vandeerslice well, located 910' FSL and 920' FWL, Section 19, T32N, R10W, San Juan County, New Mexico. This APD was approved on September 13, 2001 with an expiration date of September 13, 2002. According to our records, no known activity has taken place at this location. In view of the foregoing, this office is rescinding the approval due to the expiration of this APD.
