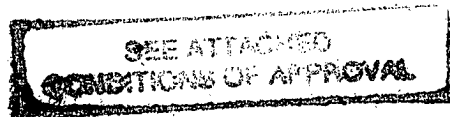

2. TOOH w/2418' 2 3/4" 4.7 EUE 8rd tubing & notched collar.
3. MIRU W/L truck. RIH & set CIBP @ 2400'. RD & Rel W/L truck.
4. TIH w/ 2 3/4" tubing. ND BOP, NU tree. Prior to landing wellhead, cir hole w/pkr fluid. Leave tubing hanging.
5. RD & Rel WOR.
6. Contact NMOC & BLM to witness pressure test. Test to 500 psi/30 min - wellhead/casing and plug.
