Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **Suspected vandal(s) removed the 2" plugs from the dump to the condensate tank, which resulted in a spill of 15 BBL condensate. The spilled fluids remained inside the secondary containment dike, and vacuum trucks recovered 7 BBL of condensate from the diked area. The spill affected the soils inside the dike in an area 25' x 15' x 8" deep. The pumping unit was shut in and the plugs replaced.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **The spilled fluids remained inside the secondary containment dike, and vacuum trucks recovered 7 BBL of condensate from the diked area. The spill affected the soils inside the dike in an area 25' x 15' x 8" deep. The pumping unit was shut in and the plugs replaced. The affected soils were excavated and hauled to Envirotech's landfarm for remediation, with clean soil being used to backfill the excavated area.**

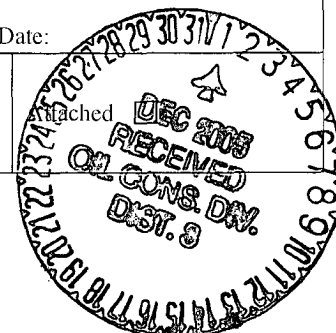
