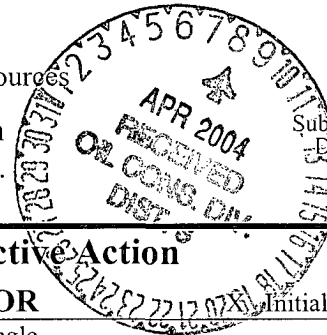

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* While digging holes in front of the fire tube hatches to line and clean the tanks, some of the holes had water run in from the sides (approx. 2 gallons). The source of the water was originally thought to be natural. However, 2 small holes were discovered in a tank. The amount of produced water that seeped from the holes is unknown.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The area affected by the spill is small area surrounding the tank. Remedial action will be determined by the agency.
