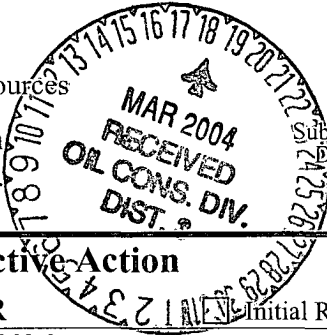

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Riser from line drip-catch froze and split. Released liquids and minor amount of natural gas. Isolated riser and initiated site remediation.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Shallow soil contamination except in the immediate area of the riser and a tank battery associated with COP well Edgar Fed. 7. Crew dispatched to remediate impacted soils and cleanup tank battery. Inclement weather hampered remediation. Cleanup completed and impacted soils remediated on 3/10/04.
