Please accept our apologies for this delayed response to your subject letter. In view of the below cited reasons, Pure Resources respectfully requests your granting of another years extension of Temporary Abandonment status for this well to finalize our current on-going evaluation. (Please see attached Form 3160-5)

Since this captioned well was Temporarily Abandoned on 11/15/02 and granted this status until December 31, 2003, Pure Resources, L. P. has undergone complete organizational changes resulting in closing of our Bloomfield, NM Office and several personnel changes over this last year (2003). All well files and records have also been re-located to our Midland Office and new engineering, geological and regulatory staffing are now familiarizing themselves with their new respective areas of responsibility. We can inform you that we are progressing on our evaluation, however. Currently the core and pressure analysis performed earlier on this well are now undergoing review by the new engineer and geologist. We are in hopes of providing you with our plans for this well as soon as this evaluation is completed and approved.

Reference is made to your well No. 10 Navajo O 18 located 660' FSL & 1975' FEL sec. 18, T. 25 N., R. 10 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, lease NMNM-20307. The subject well was approved for temporary abandonment until December 31, 2003 to evaluate. To date we have not received your plans for the above-mentioned well.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commences upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days may result in an assessment in accordance with 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management (NM-93000), P. O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115. Such requests shall not result in a suspension of the order(s) unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et seq.
