Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Drought-Booth (Canoncito) Well No. 3, to be located 804 feet from the North line and 1601 feet from the East line and in the SE/4 NW/4 NE/4 of Section 4, Township 15 North, Range 6 West, Wildcat, in McKinley County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme geologic conditions in the NE/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you are the only offset operator, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) of the Statewide Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (b) for the above described unorthodox well location. This approval supersedes approval given for this well on February 27, 1956 for another location.

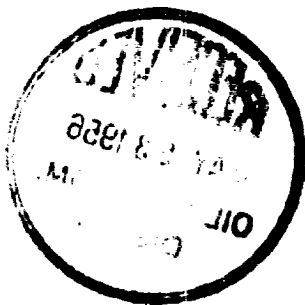

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an oil well location for your Drought-Booth (Cannito) Well No. 3, to be located 804 feet from the North line and 1661 feet from the East line and in the NW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 18 North, Range 2 West, Wilcox, New Mexico, McKinley County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this proposed well is located upon extreme geologic conditions in the NW 1/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you are the only oil operator, as is presumed in the immediate area, to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted to the provisions of Rule 104 (i) of the Statewide Rules and Regulations, an exception to Rule 104 (b) for the above described location is granted. This approval supersedes approval given for this well on January 27, 1956 for an other location.
