## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We have run 5 1/2 lb. seamless casing to a depth of 2570 feet. No water was found back of this casing, so we have hung it on clamps until we have completed a test of the sand below.

We drilled from 1225 feet to 2720 feet without any water. Found a small water stratum at 2720. We propose to plug the hole from 2720, where the well is bottomed, back to 2675 with cement. If we are successful in shutting off bottom water, we will be ready to bail down and test the formation from 2595 feet to 2675 feet. From Schlumberger Report that there is a sand from 2595 to 2675 and we believe this sand carries oil and gas. We propose to make a test for oil here.

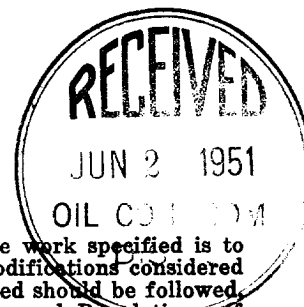
