As per our conversation in Aztec the other day, I am enclosing a diagram of our well, showing how it is capped.

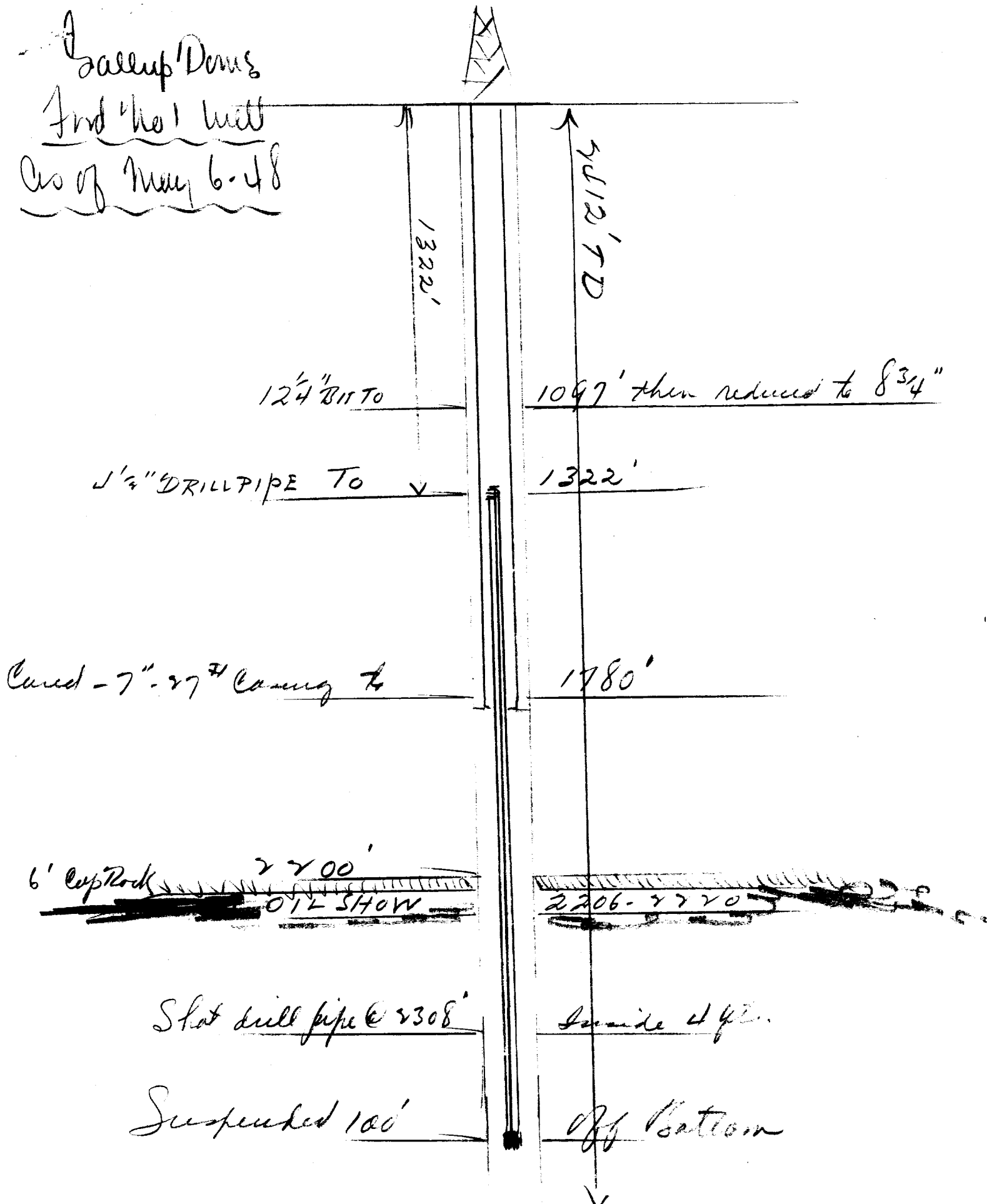

as of May 6-48

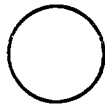


Sample Ballot

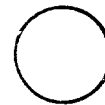
