He reported back that the well will soon be properly plugged but that the pits had never been filled or the location levelled. The rules specify that the pits shall be filled and the location levelled before the plugging bond is released.

I would suggest that you have them contact a dirt contractor in Gallup to perform the above work. At that time we will write a letter to the bonding company giving permission for cancellation of the bond.
