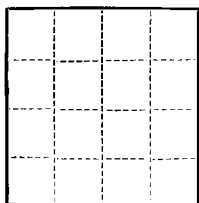

Our hole will be 4 3/4" with 10' (and 5' when necessary) cuttings in bags - Should we find oil commercially, we plan to set 300' or so, of 2 1/2" tubing 15' thru our production sands, and cement through our production zone using (if desirable) 1 band of sand on the perforating gun, to clean out sands. We plan to shoot 3 bullets per foot through oil zones & through tubing, after taking an electric log, and great extensively, if necessary - A pump, tank etc... will be installed, after instructions received.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
