
The Hesperah #1 was spudded at 8:00 A. M. July 8, 1955.

207' - 13-3/8" - N-40 seamless 8 rnd. thd. casing was set at 219' w/150 sacks of cement. The cement circulated.

After 2 1/2 hours the casing was pressured with 500 psi for 30 minutes. The test was satisfactory, so drilling was resumed with a 12-1/4" bit.
