You are hereby notified that it is our intention to
at Well No. 54 in
of Sec. 36, T. 13 N., R. 9 E., N. M. P. M., Hoopah
Oil Field, McInroy County.

The present condition of the well is as follows: On July 9 the conductor pipe was set at 43'. On July 27 ran 10,1' of 10" casing and maded same securing shutoff. On August 1 ran 1421' of 8" casing and mader. With 30 barrels of heavy mud and soft rope and secured shutoff. Arrived to hold getting oil sand at 1000. Tried to release 8" casing so lower it out from it has frozen. Arranged stick to bottom of 8" pipe and finally freed it. Cemented in when 30 sacks of Santa Cruz white well cement and 120 pounds of calcium chloride. All water above oil is now shut off by this cement job.
