The present condition of the well is as follows: On July 9 the conductor pipe was set at 43'. On July 27 ran 10 1/2' of 1 1/2" casing and mudded same securing snuff. On August 1 ran 1421' of 3/4" casing and mudded with 50 barrels of heavy mud and soft rope and secured snuff. Drilled to 1612 getting oil and at 1600. Tried to loosen 3/4" casing to lower it but found it was frozen. Bridged back to bottom of 3/4" pipe and finally freed it. Cemented it with 30 sacks of Santa Cruz oil-well cement and 120 pounds of calcium chloride. All water above oil was shut off by this cement job.
