On above date, well was opened up and flowed 15 B0 and 176 Barrels fresh water for 16 hours - fluid level never below 1,600' - Well to date on pump test and flow (4 days) has made 68 barrels new oil and 346 barrels of water. Intend to reperforate in upper zones in effort to decrease water and increase oil. Well now making 13-15 BOPD with 175-180 BOWPD.
