Gentlemen:

In your letter of June 17, 1960, concerning an allowable for the Federal 4-8 well, you advised that you needed Form C-110 and Form C128 before an allowable could be assigned.

Our files reveal that Form C-110 has been furnished and was received in your office May 26th and approved May 30th. A reproduction of the approved Form C-110 is enclosed. We will be glad to furnish new forms if you are unable to locate the ones previously submitted.

As to Form C-128, our files reveal that six copies were furnished to the U. S. Geological Survey on October 8, 1957. We have no way of knowing whether the U.S.G.S. furnished your office with sufficient copies or not. Possibly they kept all copies. We did find one file copy of the form, and have made reproductions which we enclose. If the reproductions are not acceptable, and you are unable to find copies sent from the U.S.G.S., we will write the U. S. G. S. and see if they have more copies than they need.
