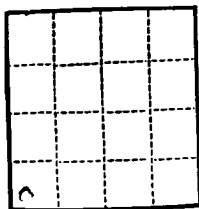


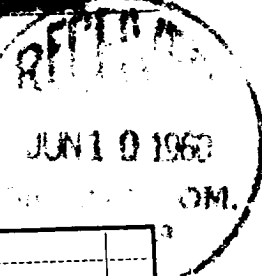

DETAILS OF WORK

Work-over rig was moved over Federal 4-8 well April 20, 1960. Well was cleaned out, treated with paraffin solvent, used tubing and rods run.

Well was pump tested with various recoveries until May 24, at 8:30 A.M. when an official 48 hour test, under supervision of Mr. P. T. McGrath, U.S.G.S. Dist Engineer, was started. Test ended at 8:30 A.M. May 26. Well had made 6 barrels of oil and 15 barrels of water in 48 hours. Daily average 3 barrels of oil and 7 1/2 barrels of water.

Well officially re-completed as a Mesquite producer May 26, 1960. No sales to date.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
