DETAILS OF WORK

A total depth of 4720 feet was reached in a 7-7/8 inch hole on July 13, 1957. On July 17, 1957, verbal permission was obtained from Mr. Plummer of the U. S. Geological Survey Office in Farmington, New Mexico to plug and abandon this well in the following manner: 20 sacks of neat cement from 4225-4290 feet, 20 sacks from 3250-3315 feet, 30 sacks from 2100-2200 feet, 40 sacks from 1550-1680 feet, 20 sacks in the bottom of the surface casing from 275-340 feet, 10 sacks in top of surface and cellar. An appropriate sign and marker will be placed at well site. The location will be restored as nearly as possible to its original status and the U. S. Geological Survey office in Farmington, New Mexico will be notified of the completion date. No commercial shows of oil or gas were encountered during the drilling of this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
