Dear Sirt

We have received your letter of December 26 stating that your #1 State well in Unit D, Section 28-20N-9W has been abandoned and plugged.

If this is the case the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission rules have been violated in the following respects:

- (1) No miscellaneous reports have been filed indicating that the well had been spudded.
- (2) No miscellaneous notice has been filed indicating casing and cementing programs or total depth reached.
- (3) Form C-105, Well Record Form, has never been filed indicating formations penetrated.
  - (4) No electric log has ever been filed with this office.
  - (5) Plugging plans were not approved by this office prior to plugging.
  - (6) No subsequent report of plugging has been filed on Form C-103.

Unless all the above information is filed and unless proper evidence can be furnished that the well has been plugged according to oil Commission specifications, it will be necessary that we require the bonding company to drill out and properly plug this well.

We are sending a supply of Forms C-103 and C-105 for your use. We will be glad to assist you in meeting the above requirements if assistance is needed.
