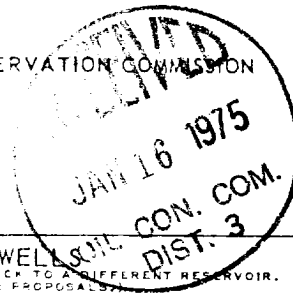

17. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work) SEE RULE 1103.

This well was completed as an injection well and used for injection August 1960 through January 1961. The well produced oil June 1961 to November 1961 and was then reconverted to an injector March 2, 1962. When current operator took over from Henry S. Birdseye the well was inactive and bull-plugged at the surface. The records available to us do not reflect the date the well became inactive. We propose to clean out 2" casing and swab test the well. If production can be reestablished we will recomplate the well. If commercial production is not established we will attempt water injection in this well for the Red Mountain flood. If neither of above succeed we will plug and abandon after filing appropriate C-103.
