Shut-In status of this well ends 12/31/93. Request that current shut-in status be extended for additional year until 12/31/94.

This well tested substantial gas reserves from the interval 2226' to 2244' which is below a cast iron bridge plug set at 2210'. Although there is currently no pipeline in the area through which the gas could be marketed, the gas may be needed in the future to supplement current field gas which is in low supply. The only other interval perforated is at 2084'. This is an oil zone but not commercial at current prices.

Casing in the well is sound and no contamination of other formations is contemplated.
