Dear Mr. Ball:

On May 3, 1966, Mr. Emery Arnold with the State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Conservation Commission contacted us relative to the above captioned well which, as you know, has been turned over to you as a water well. It is imperative that the well be properly cased so that other formations will be protected.

Inasmuch as we are responsible under our bond, the Commission will look to us for the proper plugging and abandoning of the well. We realize that a water source is vital to the ranching people in this area, and we certainly do not wish to take any steps that can be prevented.
