A copy of Mr. Emery C. Arnold's letter to you of February 22, 1967, concerning the subject well has been referred to this department for reply.

As in connection with the Santa Fe "B" Well No. 1, we wish to assure you that this well will be plugged and abandoned in accordance with the rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil & Gas Conservation Commission in the event Mr. Schmid does not take it over and attempt to complete it as a water well. As set forth in Mr. Arnold's letter, Mr. Schmid has signed agreements accepting responsibility for conversion of the well to a water well. He has at all times represented to us that he wants to make the conversion and will do so. Attached hereto is a copy of a letter which we are this day mailing to Mr. Schmid. Such letter indicates that we will move in and plug the well unless he converts it to a water well within 30 days from receipt of the letter. We are hopeful that this will bring the matter to a speedy and satisfactory conclusion. Accordingly, we ask that Mr. Arnold's request for a hearing be held in abeyance for approximately 35 days. By that time we feel that the well will have been converted to a water well or plugged and abandoned or we will be undertaking abandonment operations ourselves.

We shall look forward to hearing from you relative to our request herein contained.

As in connection with the letter of March 10, 1947, we wish to assure you that this well will be plugged and abandoned in accordance with the rules and regulations of the U.S. Conservation Commission in the event Mr. Arnold does not take it over and attempt to complete it as a water well. As set forth in Mr. Arnold's letter, Mr. Arnold has signed a certificate accepting responsibility for completion of the well as a water well. He has at all times represented to us that he intends to complete the well and we have no reason to doubt his word. Attached hereto is a copy of a letter which we are this day mailing to Mr. Arnold. Such letter indicates that we will move on and plug the well unless he converts it to a water well within 30 days from receipt of this letter. We are in the belief that this will bring the matter to a speedy and satisfactory conclusion. Accordingly, we ask that Mr. Arnold's reply be received by us on or before March 25, 1947. We are hoping to hear an explanation from Mr. Arnold by March 25, 1947, that this well will have been converted to a water well or plugged and abandoned so as to be unusable for any purpose whatsoever.

We shall look forward to hearing from you and will be glad to discuss the matter further if desired.

You have received a copy of Mr. Emery C. Arnold's letter of February 22, 1967, to Mr. George Hatch, Assistant Attorney General of the State of New Mexico, requesting a hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission relative to the subject well. It is our understanding that you want to convert this well to a water well and have agreed to make the conversion and accept the responsibility therefor. Accordingly, we hereby call upon you and make demand upon you to immediately make the desired conversion. As you can see from Mr. Arnold's letter, the Commission is demanding that immediate action be taken. Accordingly, unless you have commenced and completed conversion of the subject well to a water well to the satisfaction of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission within 30 days from receipt of this letter, it is our intent to, and we will have no alternative but to, move onto the location and plug and abandon the well in accordance with the rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

We regret having to write this letter to you and put this matter to you in this fashion. However, the point and time have been reached where we have no alternative but to do so. We sincerely hope that you will comply with the obligations which you originally undertook and that you will complete the conversion within the time above provided.
