Dear Sir:

As stated in my letter of December 19, 1966 and as Mr. Ben Jones and myself discussed in our meeting with you prior to the drilling of the Santa Fe "B" No. 1 Well, Tidewater Oil Company has no objection to turning over the bore-hole including the 7-5/8" surface casing set and cemented to 116' to you for your attempted conversion to a water well for livestock purposes, provided the conversion is acceptable to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

The work performed in attempting to convert to a water well and related costs would be the responsibility of you, the landowner.

Please let me know if you desire the bore-hole for water well purposes, conversion to be at your expense, or if you wish Tidewater Oil Company to finish plugging.
