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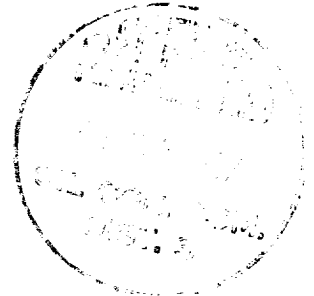

Records indicate this well was drilled to a total depth of 475 feet in 1964. On August 20, 1964, Notice of Intention to Plug was filed and approved.

We have never received subsequent report of plugging for this well, or have we received Well Record Form, Form C-105.

We therefore presume that the well has not been plugged and are by copy of this letter recommending to our legal department that a hearing be set to have Chaco Oil Co. and the bonding company show cause why the well should not be plugged and abandoned in accordance with Oil Conservation Commission rules.

If the well was plugged, we will drop the above action upon receipt of the indicated information and after making a field inspection of the location.
