Consolidated has succeeded to all the interests of Worldwide Petroleum Corporation in the State of New Mexico; hence this letter on its stationery.

In accordance with Mr. Trujillo's letter, I am enclosing the original copy of the Bill of Sale from Worldwide Petroleum Corporation to Schmid Properties, Inc., whose president is W. A. Schmid, Jr., P.O. Box 9681, Fort Worth, Texas, 76107. By this Bill of Sale, Schmid Properties, Inc. agrees to plug and abandon the above described water well which was sold to it as set forth in paragraph 1 of page 1 of the Bill of Sale.

We would like to have your approval of this Bill of Sale as constituting the affidavit of responsibility of Schmid Properties, Inc. in regard to the plugging and abandoning of said well so that Worldwide Petroleum Corporation may be released from its \$10,000.00 blanket plugging bond #31380-13-736-65. Consolidated itself has a blanket plugging bond



#31380-13-468-62. If the Worldwide bond is not cancelled, Consolidated is obligated to pay two \$100.00 permiums a year for similar bonds covering this one well.

We would like your decision permitting the cancellation of Worldwide Petroleum Corporation's bond so that we may advise our insurance agent.
