Notice of Intention to Drill was filed for the above well and approved 8-29-64.

No subsequent reports have been filed on this well indicating that the well was spudded. On March 7, 1966, after communication with the operator, we received a copy of an electric log indicating the well had been drilled to a total depth of 467 feet.

I am recommending that at your earliest convenience a hearing be set to have the operator and the bonding company show cause why this well should not be plugged in accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission rules and regulations.
