This is the well that started the whole thing. Please look at the last page of copies, which is the official completion report. It shows 9' of sand with good stain, odor and fluorescence, at the top with a water sand near the bottom. The drill stem test tested the entire zone which would not be a good test since the water would flow preferentially to the oil especially since the mud had had a chance to clog up the formation. The fresh water in the formations make log interpretations hazardous at best, therefore sample and core interpretations are best. Anyone with experience in logging salt water filled sands goes nuts trying to figure out fresh water areas.

This well should be used as a water injection well.
