Dear Mr. Slaughter:

Notice of Intention to Drill was received in this office for your Alice Rosetta #1 well located in the southwest quarter of Section 16, Township 20 North, Range 9 West on February 29, 1968. The notice was approved on April 10, 1968, which was the date we received notice of bond approval from our Santa Fe Office.

I believe you were mailed a copy of New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules & Regulations at an earlier date. Please note that the section on drilling and reports requires the filing of Commission form C-103, Sundry Notices and Reports on Wells, to be filed within ten days following the date of spudding of a well giving drilling, casing and cementing details. Also within 20 days following completion of a well form C-105 must be filed giving a complete summary of drilling activity, equipment installation, tests and other pertinent data.

If your well has been spudded or completed will you please take immediate steps to comply with the above regulations? In the event of a dry hole the Commission must also be notified so that a plugging program may be approved and accomplished.

May we please hear from you concerning the above matter?
