Dear Mr. Woods:

NMOCD field inspection revealed that the referenced well was flowing water and oil onto the ground. NMOCD Rule No. 703 states in part that injection projects, including injection wells and producing wells and all related surface facilities shall be operated and maintained at all times in such a manner as will confine the injected fluids to the interval or intervals approved and prevent surface damage or pollution resulting from leaks, breaks, or spills. Injection wells or projects which have exhibited failure to confine injected fluids to the authorized injection zone or zones may be subject to restriction of injection volume and pressure, or shut-in, until the failure has been identified and corrected. In order to comply with NMOCD Rule No. 703, you are hereby directed to cap the referenced well immediately.
