ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4263, Tenneco Oil Company has made application to the Commission on December 13, 1973, for permission to expand its Lone Pine Dakota "D" Pressure Maintenance Project in the Lone Pine Dakota "D" Oil Pool in McKinley County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 14th day of December, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That there are no offset operators and the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-4263 may be waived.
3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to gas injection under the terms of Order No. R-4263.
4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Tenneco Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Dakota "D" formation through the following described well for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Lone Pine Dakota "D" Unit (LPDDU) Well No. 11 located in Unit D of Section 16, Township 17 North, Range 8 West, NM.
