Drilled 7-7/8" hole to 8576'. Ran Halliburton DST #1 - 8546' to 8576'. Open 5 minutes, shut in 60 minutes, flow 30 minutes and shut in 60 minutes. No blow of gas. Recovered 90' of mud, 90' of mud out water and 620' of salt water. Recovered total of 4.77 barrels. HP in & out 4334 psi, Initial open pressure 160 psi, ISIP 3834 psi, IFP 286 psi, FFP 399 psi, FSIP 3702 psi. BHT 226°.

Resumed drilling 7-7/8" hole at 8576'.

Instructions
