S. in Durango, Colorado and plugged and abandoned as follows: Spotted 45 sack cement plug No. 1 from 8600' to 8500'; 60 sack cement plug No. 2 from 8075' to 7975'; 45 sack cement plug No. 3 from 6275' to 6175'; 80 sack cement plug No. 4 from 5200' to 5100'; 55 sack cement plug No. 5 from 4225' to 4125', across 8-5/8" shoe at 4179'. WOC 4 hours. Checked top plug at 4025'. Spotted 5 sack surface plug. Installed dry hole marker. Plugged and abandoned July 20, 1970. Will advise when location is ready for final inspection.
