LF well connect plug No. 2 from 6300' to 3500'; 60 sack cement plug No. 2 from 5000' to 7200'; 60 sack cement plug No. 3 from 6275' to 6175'; 30 sack cement plug No. 4 from 5230' to 5000'; 55 sack cement plug No. 5 from 4275' to 4125'; across 2-5/8" shows a 10' - 19' and 5' open plug at surface. The well dry hole marker and clean location.


