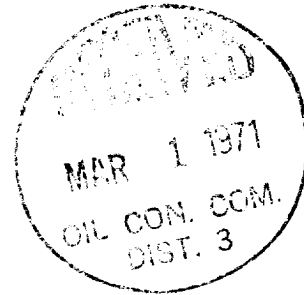

We request administrative approval to increase the dedicated acreage from eighty (80) to ninety-one and 44/100 (91.44) acres on the above subject well.

1. The Units involved are contiguous.
2. They are part of the same basic lease, carrying the same royalty interest - Tenneco Oil Company 80% and Santa Fe Pacific RR 20%.
3. The ownership of the Units involved is 100% Tenneco Oil Company.

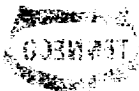

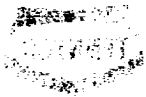
