1. Spool 12" hole 2/3/71 w/rathole rig. Ran 3 fts. 8 5/8" 24#, J-5 Casing set at 85' MDL meas. Cemented w/40 sx regular cement w/ 2 G-Cl. Circulated approx 20 sx to surface.
2. HCO Young Drilling Co. 2/7/71. Hiple up and test casing and 100 to 500 psi for 30 min. Drilled under surface w/ 7/8" hole to 50 2/01 on 2/9/71
3. Ran Schlumberger Electric Logs to 50. Ran 90 fts. 4 1/2" O.D. 9.5", J-5 500 Casing and set at 2900' MDL meas. Cemented w/40 sx Class C cement w/10 salt. Good circulation thru-out. Pumped plug w/1500 psi. Held 6. Plug down at 6:50 AM 2-10-71.
4. Run until 2/11/71. Perforate Dakota "B" sand from 2832-37' MDL meas. (2 holes per foot, total 10 holes). Ran 89 fts 2 3/8" 4.75", J-5 100 tubing set at 2'22' MDL meas.
5. Acidize perfic w/500 gallons 15% acid 2/12/71. Such tubing to test tank. Flowing well to test tank for potential test.

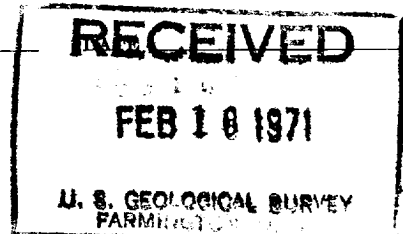

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.

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
