ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2807-B, Tesoro Petroleum Corporation has made application to the Commission on May 11, 1972 for permission to expand its Hospah Unit Water Flood Project in the Hospah Pool, McKinley County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 15th day of May, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2807-B.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2807-B.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Tesoro Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Hospah Sand formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit-Well No. 70 located in Unit N of Section 36, Township 18 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, and Unit

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set at approximately 1620 feet in said wells.
