Plugging Summary:

8-24-99 Move equipment to location. RU 1-1/2" coiled tubing unit and RIH to 710'. Circulate hole clean with 10 bbls water. Plug #1 with 20 sxs Class B cement inside 4-1/2' casing to fill perforation from 710' to 460'. POH with 1-1/2" coiled tubing.

8-25-99 Road cement equipment back to location. RU A-Plus wireline truck. Pressure test 4-1/2" casing to 500#, held OK. Perforate 3 bi-wire squeeze holes at 100'. Attempt to establish circulation out 7" casing, pressured up to 500#. RIH with 1-1/2" coiled tubing to 250'. Plug #2 with 32 sxs Class B cement from 250' to surface, circulate 1 bbl good cement out 4 1/2" casing. POH with 1-1/2" coiled tubing. RD cementing equipment and move off location. Weld on P&A marker.
