Cement is circulated behind the 8-5/8" surface casing set at 104 feet. A 7-7/8" hole was drilled to total depth of 4907 feet with a rotary rig, on March 29, 1973. Schlumberger logs were run to total depth.

It is proposed to plug and abandon the well using the rig on location by setting cement plugs with drill pipe as follows:

Plug from 4907' to 4807' with 30 sacks  
Plug from 3560' to 3460' with 30 sacks  
Plug from 2820' to 2720' with 30 sacks  
Plug from 1630' to 1530' with 30 sacks  
Plug from 50' to surface with 15 sacks

Work is expected to begin March 31, 1973. Verbal approval was given by Aztec District Office.
