Reference is made to your application for approval of non-standard oil well locations for your Santa Fe RR Well No. 34 to be located 95 feet from the North line and 2600 feet from the East line of Section 29, your Santa Fe RR Well No. 35 to be located 160 feet from the North line and 2135 feet from the East line of Section 29, and your Santa Fe RR Well No. 36 to be located 265 feet from the South line and 2150 feet from the East line of Section 20, all in Township 20 North, Range 9 West, N1PM, Red Mountain-Menefee Pool, McKinley County, New Mexico.
