Dear Kr. Wilson:

At the time you drilled the above well you called for plugging instructions and were given a plugging plan. New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission rules and regulations require the following:

- 1. Within 10 days following commencement of drilling operations the operator of the well shall file a report thereof on Form C-103 in triplicate. This report shall indicate the hour and date the well was spudded.
- 2. A report of casing and cerent test shall be filed by the operator of the well within 10 days following the setting of a string of casing or liner.
- 3. A notice of Intention to Plug shall be filed in triplicate setting out plugging plans for approval by the Commission. (To prevent the cost of rig time while awaiting approval, it is the Commission's policy to approve plugging plans orally, but the plan agreed upon must be submitted in writing for subsequent approval so that the well file will reflect that the plugging was approved.)
- 4. A report of plugging operations shall be filed by the operator of the well within 30 days following completion of plugging operations on any well. Said report shall be filed in triplicate on Form C-103 and shall include the date the plugging operations were begun and completed and shall detail an account of where each plug was set, the size and depth of casing left in the hole and other pertinent information.
 - 5. Within 20 days following the completion or recompletion of any well the operator shall file form C-105 with the Commission. It must be filed in quintuplicate and must be accompanied by a summary of special tests conducted on the well. In addition one copy of all electrical and radio activity logs run on the well must be filed with form C-105.

Our file on your #1 Bullseve well indicates that nothing has been filed other than a form C-101, Application for Permit to Drill, which was filed on


